Vision/mission statement



US forest products are among the most sustainably and responsibly managed in the world. US timber harvest and replanting legislation protects public and private forests and has resulted in timber growth exceeding harvest volume since 1940. The volume of standing timber in the U.S. is now 34% greater than in 1977.

SEC's mission is to educate international specifiers and end users about the environmental and carbon reduction benefits of using softwoods in construction and furniture applications. SEC and its members also participate in international codes and standards, committees and life cycle assessment committees to ensure that U.S. forest products enjoy open market access.

Key areas of focus

Codes and standards committees, Circular Economy and Life Cycle Assessment committees, education and outreach, research to identify new markets for US products, trade shows, education for international furniture manufacturers and construction industry representatives, trade shows.

Accomplishments with historic/trend data

The U.S. has more trees today than 70 years ago, with over 1 billion seedlings planted annually.

Responsible forest management has resulted in more than 50 consecutive years of net forest growth exceeding annual removals.



U.S. timberlands, representing two-thirds of U.S. forest area, have a total volume of live trees exceeding 28 billion cubic meters.U.S. forests grow 700 cubic meters every two minutes.
